The Town of Bristol, NH (pop 3,300 and 22.3 square miles) seeks a Chief of Police to oversee the day to day operations including the administrative oversight of the department in accordance with RSA 105. The Town of Bristol, nestled in the heart of the Lakes Region, has a population of just over 3,300 people and is a great community in which to live, work and play. Our community also has a large summer population. Bristol is a multi-service municipality with full-time police, fire, highway, ambulance, town office staff, as well as water and sewer departments.

Candidates must demonstrate leadership and self-knowledge, along with a proven record of managing people through a collaborative team approach. Outstanding analytical, communication, financial and planning skills are essential. Candidates should possess a Bachelor's Degree and five to ten years of supervisory experience. An equivalent combination of education and experience may be considered. The salary range for this position is \$60,000 - \$65,000 and includes a generous benefit package.

Residency is not required but preferred.
