2. State and National Register Evaluation




3. Preservation Plan

Survey Methods

- Field survey
 - Baseline documentation (# of markers, size of area, fence or wall material, etc.)
 - Conditions assessment (e.g., vegetation encroachment, marker conditions)
 - Identification of archaeological sensitivity
 - Walkover and digital photography
 - Unmanned Aerial System (UAS) survey
- Historical Background
- Reporting NHDHR Inventory Forms, GIS data
- Recommendations







Keyser: Micro-topography






Recommendations


- Education and Outreach (signage, school projects)
