### **Meeting Minutes**

Advertising: Ed Mendelbaum has offered to pay for the events info to be incorporated into the Plymouth General Dentistry ad in the Weirs Times. Claire will contact him with the info. Claire will work on the posters for the concerts and get them to Les to print.

OHD banners: We need to locate these.

OHD: Kim found a number of potential water games for OHD. She has also been contacted by Ken at White Mountain Catering and he would like to do pizza during OHD. Les suggested he follow up with Christina at the Town Hall to see what permits he will need. There is a person with a sausage & hot dog cart that is interested in being there. We already have the Lion's doing hotdogs so we would not want to duplicate that.

We need to put an article in the paper after OHD this year to thank all of the volunteers and teens. We also need to pick the people for the 'Community Recognition'. Les will follow up with Mad River Tent Rentals regarding the tents. She will also contact Carroll regarding the parade and Old Home Day. It was suggested that we invite the Police Chief and family to the Lobster & Chicken Dinner.

Parade: We need judges. Barb will check with Lorraine and Janice to see if they will work the parade again. We need to get the parade info posted to all of the websites. Bebe Wood & John Bianchi have accepted being the Grand Marshalls for the parade. Barb will check with the Hubers to see if they will drive them again this year.

We need to get the good buckets for the flags from Hilda.
