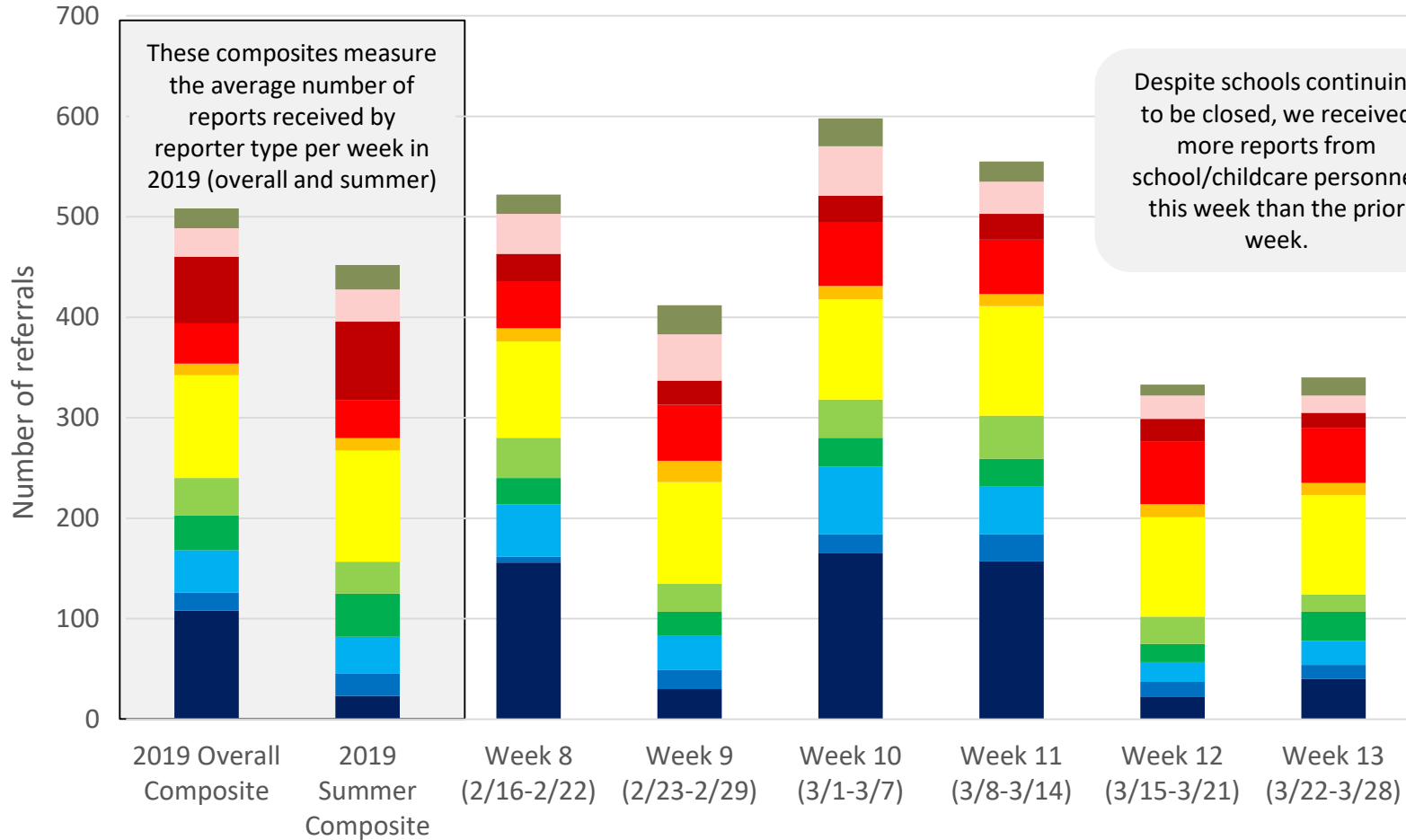

| Court/Probation/GAL | 4% | -8% | 12 |
| Parent/Guardian/Family | 38% | -11% | 55 |
| Anonymous/Unknown | -77% | -35% | 15 |
| Medical | -40% | -26% | 17 |
| Other Comm. Agency | -14% | 64% | 18 |
